What is “JuLeiCa?”

The Youth Leader Card (short: JuLeiCa) is a nationwide uniform and officially recognised license for volunteers in children's and youth work. Hence, young persons who completed the respective training and want to volunteer or are already volunteering in youth associations, youth groups and youth clubs will receive the card.

How do I get the JuLeiCa?

You must at least be 16 years old and must have attended both modules. Also, attending an 8-hour first-aid course is obligatory.

The JuLeiCa program

Module I:

- Basic knowledge of children's and youth work
- Youth groups and the team
- Group psychology & group leadership
- Handling of conflicts in the group
- Basics of communication
- Experiential education

Module II:

- Legal matters in youth work and protection of minors
- Project management & fund-raising
- Methods of intercultural youth work
- Methods of diversity education

When does the JuLeiCa training take place?

Module I: 31 March - 2 April 2017 at Halle/Saale

Module II: 21 April - 23 April 2017 at Dessau



During the JuLeiCa workshops you will stay with the entire group in a youth hostel. You will be accommodated in shared rooms, separated by gender. Catering, program fees and travels costs are included for the event. There is a symbolic participation fee of 10,- € for each module.
